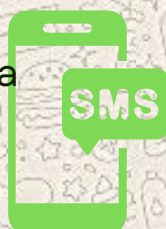


4 Steps to Avoid WhatsApp Theft



1. NEVER SHARE YOUR CODE

Your activation code. It is the 6 digits you receive via text message (SMS).

ACTIVATE TWO-STEP VERIFICATION "YOUR PERSONAL PIN"

Establish a personal PIN that is the "Two-Step Verification" so that your account is doubly protected; you will be asked for an email address.

KEEP YOUR "RESTRICTED" PHOTO

Make your profile picture visible only to your contacts.

CHECK THAT YOUR CONTACTS ARE "LEGITIMATE"

If a family member or friend makes an unusual request via WhatsApp, verify their identity with a call.



WHATSAPP

Favorite Uncle

I'm trying to make a payment right now, but my account is not giving me access to transfer. Could you please send them for me, and I will definitely return them to you later.



WHATSAPP

Best friend

I need to receive a regular text message and my mailbox is giving me problems; it doesn't want to work. Could you please do me the favor of receiving the message for me?



If you suspect that someone else is using your WhatsApp account, you should notify your family and friends, as that person could impersonate you in your individual and group chats.
