# THE MALWARE

When gifts arrive... so do attacks. Check out these examples and don't fall into the trap.



**Christmas phishing:** Fake emails from Amazon or Mercado Libre that simulate purchase confirmations and lead to malicious links.



**Malware disguised as parcels:** Messages that mimic DHL or FedEx notices with fake shipping labels.



**Malicious digital Christmas cards:** Files or links that, when opened, download malware.



**Malware in payroll receipts:** Emails that mimic payment receipts with infected attachments.



One accidental click can ruin your year-end, so think twice before doing it.
